

Find A New Way

Construction work has begun on I-105 in Eugene between the Washington/Jefferson Bridge and I-5. Between early May and late June, an average of 66,000 daily trips along I-105 will have to navigate around five key closures along this corridor. Major traffic impacts will affect residents, businesses, commuters, and visitors throughout the region.

Commuter Solutions has partnered with Lane Council of Governments (LCOG) and the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) to let the community know, well ahead of time, strategies and options to avoid expected congestion. They include traveling at less busy times, carpooling with neighbors or coworkers, taking alternate routes, using transit, bicycling, walking, and other alternatives to driving whenever possible.
