

## **Single lane restriction on 1-105 eastbound between Delta Highway on and off ramps**

EUGENE—Starting Tuesday evening at 7 p.m., the contractor working on the I-105 Highway Improvement Project will start an around-the-clock restriction to a single lane for eastbound I-105 traffic between the Delta Highway off ramp and the Delta Highway on ramp.

Traffic will be shifted to the left lane so Delta Highway on ramp vehicles will be able to enter the right hand lane from a realigned ramp alignment. This lane restriction is needed for reconstruction of the on ramp. The reconstruction and paving should be completed by Saturday night and motorists should expect delays during peak evening and morning periods.

I-105 construction work that will include major traffic impacts is expected to start Thursday at 6 a.m. when the east bound lane of I-105 over I-5 will be closed for construction for eight days, with only west bound traffic allowed.
