

Accelerated Closure Schedule

Weekly Construction Update June 6-13

CLOSURE 2 -- westbound over I-5 -- expected to be completed Thursday, June 9 at 6am

Motorists need to be aware of the following:

- Westbound motorists on Highway 126 (from Springfield) will have to exit to northbound I-5 (toward Coburg). Motorists can then take the next exit; Beltline Highway as a detour;
- Westbound motorists on Highway 126 (from Springfield) can not go south on to I-5. Motorists will be rerouted north to the Beltline exit and will then need to take either Coburg Road or Delta Highway;
- Use routes across I-5 farther south such as Harlow, Franklin Blvd., and 30th Ave.

CLOSURE 3 -- westbound lanes (from I-5 or Springfield toward Eugene) of I-105 over Coburg Rd. began Friday, June 3

Expected completion, Wednesday, June 15

Motorists need to be aware of the following:

- Westbound traffic (from I-5 or Springfield) will be required to exit I-105 at Coburg Road;
- Traffic can merge back onto the highway by crossing Coburg Rd. and taking the onramp at Country Club Rd.

This weekend -- June 10-15-- an additional section will be closed:

- The Washington-Jefferson/Delta interchange will also be closed to through traffic;
- From Eugene, the entrance to eastbound I-105 from 6th, 7th, or Washington Sts. Will be closed;
- Westbound traffic (from I-5 or Springfield) will be required to exit I-105 at Coburg Rd. **AND will not** be able to merge back onto I-105 by crossing Coburg Rd. and taking the onramp at Country Club Rd.;

Motorists are encouraged to avoid I-105 during this time.

Alternate routes include:

Beltline, Oakway Rd., Franklin Blvd., Harlow Rd., Country Club Rd. and MLK Blvd.

ODOT's contractor on the job, Oregon Mainline Paving, has been working on the project since January building new auxiliary lanes, upgrading guard and bridge rails and bringing the shoulder and median barriers up to current standards. Most of the work is expected to be finished by the end of the summer.

Motorists are encouraged to continue to visit this web site and to "Find a New Way" both during and after construction.
