

# Weekly Construction Update

## June 10 to June 17

Work on the I-105 Highway Improvement Project is ahead of schedule. With the addition of more resources for the project, the schedule has been accelerated and the project should be completed in a shorter timeframe.

Both directions of I-105 over I-5 are now open. The northbound I-5 to westbound Eugene ramp, Exit 194B, remains closed.

The westbound lanes over Coburg Road are now closed. All traffic is diverted off I-105 to Coburg Road. Traffic may travel down Southwood Lane re-enter westbound I-105 at the Southwood Lane/ Country Club Rd on-ramp.

Beginning Friday, June 10th, the contractor will start work on the Delta Highway Interchange. This work will last four days, re-opening Tuesday, June 14th at 6:00 a.m. During this closure, no traffic will be allowed onto westbound I-105 at the Southwood Lane on-ramp. Traffic will be detoured on Country Club Road to Delta Highway near Valley River Center. Northbound I-105 will be closed at 7th Street. Southbound traffic from Delta Highway will be able to continue south to Jefferson Street or access eastbound I-105.

### **Closure of Westbound lanes of I-105 at Coburg Rd Overcrossing June 3 – June 15:**

- Both lanes are closed at the Coburg Road off-ramp Friday, June 3 at 6 a.m. and will remain closed until approximately 6 a.m. Wednesday, June 15. From June 3 through June 10, westbound traffic will be able to proceed through the signals at Coburg Road and access I-105 from the Southwood on-ramp. From June 10 through June 15, the Southwood on-ramp will be closed;
- The ramp from I-5 north to Eugene/I-105/OR 126 (Exit #194B) will be closed;
- The northbound Washington/Jefferson Street Bridge over the Willamette River will be closed from Friday, June 10 through Tuesday, June 14;
- **The recommended detour route to access I-105** is to take Beltline Road west to Delta Highway and then south on Delta Highway to I-105. **The recommended detour route on I-5 north for traffic that is bound for Eugene** is to take Exit #192 Franklin Boulevard. **The recommended detour route on I-5 south for traffic that is bound for Eugene** is to take Exit #195 Beltline. Detour signs will be in place ; and
- The eastbound lanes of I-105 will remain open.

The speed limit within the project limits has been reduced to 45 miles per hour. ODOT's contractor on the I-105 project, Oregon Mainline Paving of McMinnville will close the westbound I-105 flyover exit ramp to southbound Coburg Road Sunday through Thursday nights from 7:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m. to work on re-facing the bridge rail. The traffic will still use the Coburg Road exit. However, rather than using the flyover ramp, they will need to make a left at the traffic signal.

Expect one-lane closures on I-105 from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. between the Pioneer Parkway Interchange and the Delta Highway interchange in both directions. No lane closures, other than those described above, are anticipated for daytime work. Motorists should watch for lane closure signs and traffic control barrels.

As I-105 work continues, the contractor will be working around the clock and the community may experience significant traffic impacts. There is a \$35,000 per day incentive for the contractor to finish the work ahead of schedule.
